Eligibility

The Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest is open to all Catholic students – in public, private or parochial schools – in grades 8,9,10,11and 12 during the current school year.

Guidelines

- Essays must reflect the assigned theme and be the student's original work.
- Essays must be typed and be between 500 and 750 words in length. Use 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 11" paper, one sided, double spaced, with one-inch margins.
- The student's name should appear only on the official Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest entry form, which must be stapled to the essay.
- All entries become the property of the Knights of Columbus and will not be returned.
- Return your entry by October 31 to the St. William office; tell them it is for the Knights of Columbus.
- The first place winner in each grade will receive a \$50 award from the Chisholm Trail Council, with the opportunity to win more at the district, state and international levels.
